Cadney, Sr. Mother Allen was the seventh of eleven children. Mother Allen transitioned this life to her heavenly home on Friday, September 5, 2025, at the Madison County Nursing Home in Canton, Mississippi. Three brothers, George Smith, Lee Rumble, and Willie Smith; and two sisters, Maxine Knight, and Dorine Brantley preceded her in death; along with her aunts, Louise Thompson, Lillian Cadney and Leoner Pickett.

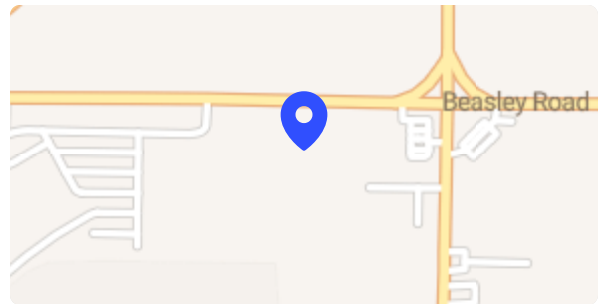

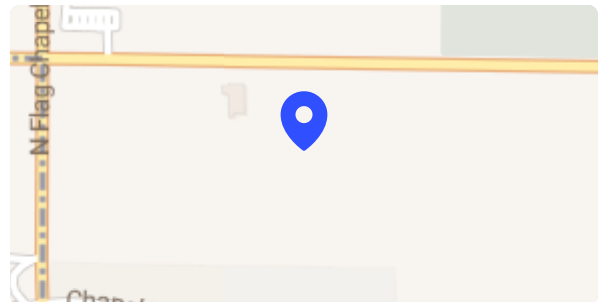

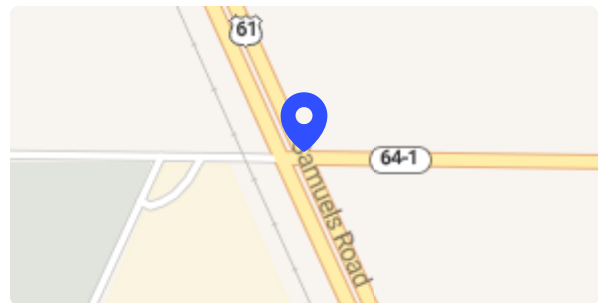
